

**CITY OF PLAINFIELD  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
August 14, 2007**

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Tom Geise and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Tim Neil.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session August 14, 2007 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tim Neil presiding and council members Kyle Adams, Clyde Balvanz, Tom Geise and Larry Miller present. Mike Hyde was absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: Maintenance Supervisor Steve Janssen and Fire Chief Tom Poppe and Librarian Kim Bigelow.

Motion Geise, Adams to approve the agenda. Ayes: Adams, Balvanz, Geise and Miller. Nays: None. Absent: Hyde. MC.

During Open Time for Comments from the public, a group of concerned citizens were present to discuss the quality of the seeding on Main Street after the completion of the Main Street Project.

Fire Chief Tom Poppe reported to the Council that the Fire Department received a grant from the Department of Homeland Security for a new breathing air compressor and eight new SCBA's.

Librarian Kim Bigelow reported to the Council that the Library received an Empowerment Grant for \$2000 to promote reading readiness in 0-5 yr. olds.

Motion Geise, Balvanz to supply 30 tons of black dirt and 1 bag of seed per lot to repair the area between the curb and sidewalk on Main Street. The seed will be delivered to each house, and when the location for the dirt is determined it will be posted at the Post Office, City Hall and on the Butler-Bremer Channel.
