

**CITY OF PLAINFIELD  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
August 11, 2009**

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Mayor Tim Neil and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Clyde Balvanz.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session August 11, 2009 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tim Neil presiding and council members Kyle Adams, Clyde Balvanz and Kathy Remley present. Council Members Tom Geise and Larry Poppe were absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: City Clerk Brittney Lentz, Fire Chief Tom Poppe Librarian Kim Bigelow and Maintenance Supervisor Steve Janssen.

Motion Adams, Balvanz to approve the agenda. Ayes: Adams, Balvanz and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Adams, Remley to approve the consent agenda; which included the minutes of July 7, 2009, bills for the month of August 2009 and the Clerk's Reports. Ayes: Adams, Balvanz and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Bremer Co. Auditor Lynn Brase and Chickasaw Co. Auditor Joan Knoll were present to discuss changing the election polling location. The new polling location for all elections is now the Nielsen Room of the Plainfield Public Library.

The City of Plainfield received four bids for the re-roofing of the Plainfield Public Library. Motion Balvanz, Remley to approve the low bid of \$10,922.55 with Burnished Slate colored steel from Leo Deutsch Construction. Ayes: Adams, Balvanz and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

City Clerk Lentz submitted an insurance claim for the water leak/damage at the Public Library.

The City of Plainfield received \$4,244 in IJOB funding to be used towards road maintenance.

Motion Adams, Remley to approve the purchase of a generator for the water tower from Electrical Engineering & Equipment at a total cost of \$13,400 and an LP tank for the generator from Lou's LP for \$900. The City will be using the Community Disaster grant money they received to pay for half of the cost. Ayes: Adams, Balvanz and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Balvanz, Adams to accept the monthly department reports. Ayes: Adams, Balvanz and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Discussion was held on the next Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation meeting on August 25 in Tripoli. Council Members Adams and Geise will be attending this meeting along with Mayor Neil and Maintenance Supervisor Janssen.

Council Member Adams had nothing new to report on the Welcome Sign.
