**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
**July 7, 2009**

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Mayor Tim Neil and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Steve Janssen.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session July 7, 2009 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tim Neil presiding and council members Kyle Adams, Larry Poppe and Kathy Remley present. Council Members Clyde Balvanz and Tom Geise were absent.
