**June 9, 2009**

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session June 9, 2009 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tim Neil presiding and council members Kyle Adams, Tom Geise, Larry Poppe and Kathy Remley present. Council Member Clyde Balvanz was absent.

The Plainfield Fire Dept. was awarded a \$2,000 grant from the Bremer County Community Foundation.
