

**CITY OF PLAINFIELD
CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

May 12, 2009

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Pastor Shawn Geer of the First Baptist Church of Plainfield and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Steve Janssen.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session May 12, 2009 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro Tem Tom Geise presiding and council members Clyde Balvanz, Tom Geise, Larry Poppe and Kathy Remley present. Council Member Kyle Adams was absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: City Clerk Brittney Lentz, Fire Chief Tom Poppe and Maintenance Supervisor Steve Janssen.

Motion Balvanz, Remley to approve the agenda. Ayes: Balvanz, Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Absent: Adams. Carried.

Motion Poppe, Remley to approve the consent agenda; which included the minutes of April 14, 2009, bills for the month of May 2009 and the Clerk's Reports. Ayes: Balvanz, Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Absent: Adams. Carried.

Mayor Pro Tem Geise proclaimed May 10-16, 2009 as Iowa School Board Recognition Week.
