

**CITY OF PLAINFIELD  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
November 12, 2009**

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Mayor Tim Neil and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Tom Geise.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session November 12, 2009 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tim Neil presiding and council members Tom Geise, Larry Poppe and Kathy Remley present. Council Members Kyle Adams and Clyde Balvanz were absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: City Clerk Brittney Lentz, Fire Chief Tom Poppe and Maintenance Supervisor Steve Janssen.

Motion Geise, Remley to approve the agenda. Ayes: Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Geise, Poppe to approve the consent agenda; which included the minutes of October 13, 2009, bills for the month of November 2009 with the addition of one bill and the Clerk's Reports. Ayes: Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

City Clerk Lentz will be attending the yearly budget workshop on Thursday, December 3.

Fire Chief Poppe presented the first draft of the 28E agreement between the City of Plainfield and Plainfield Fire Department for mutual aid fire and emergency response in and surrounding Bremer County.

Mayor Tim Neil appointed Jeanette Pagel to the Plainfield Public Library Board of Trustees.

Mayor Neil read a thank-you card from the Library Trustees for the new roof on the Library.

Motion Geise, Remley to approve the proposal from Weitzenkamp Home Improvement to install seamless gutters on the Library. Ayes: Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Janssen informed the Council that the new generator at the water tower is installed and ready to be used.

Motion Poppe, Remley to accept the monthly department reports. Ayes: Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

City Council members are looking into building a new city building to replace City Hall and the City Shed. Council Members Balvanz and Poppe along with Maintenance Supervisor Janssen will be looking into this further.

Wild Animals was tabled until the March 2010 council meeting.

The City received a generous donation from the Plainfield Sportsmen's Club, to go towards the construction of a welcome sign.
