CITY COUNCIL MEETING
April 10, 2012**

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session April 10, 2012 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tom Geise presiding and Council Members Doug Berger, Shawn Geer and Kathy Remley present. Council Members Kyle Adams and Clyde Balvanz were absent.
