April 9, 2013**

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Pastor Shawn Geer and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Tom Geise.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session April 9, 2013 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tom Geise presiding and Council Members Clyde Balvanz, Doug Berger, Shawn Geer and Kathy Remley present. Council Member Kyle Adams was absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: City Clerk Tabatha Caswell and Maintenance Supervisor Andy Luck.

Motion Geer, seconded by Balvanz to approve the agenda with the addition of the 28E Agreement. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried

Council Member Kyle Adams entered the meeting at 7:03pm.

Motion Balvanz, seconded by Remley to approve the consent agenda; which included the minutes of March 12, 2013, bills for the month of April 2013 and the Clerk's Reports. Ayes: Adams, Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.
