December 11, 2012**

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session December 11, 2012 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro-tem Clyde Balvanz presiding and Council Members Kyle Adams, Doug Berger, Shawn Geer and Kathy Remley present. Mayor Tom Geise was absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: City Clerk Brittney Lentz, Fire Chief Tom Poppe, Librarian Clarence Bergmann and Maintenance Superintendent Andy Luck.
