The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session December 12, 2013 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro-tem Clyde Balvanz presiding and Council Members Kyle Adams, Shawn Geer, Kathy Remley and Joe Schmall present. Mayor Tom Geise was absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: City Clerk Tabatha Caswell and Maintenance Superintendent Andy Luck, along with 1 visitor.
