

**CITY OF PLAINFIELD
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
October 9, 2012**

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Pastor Shawn Geer and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Clyde Balvanz.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session October 9, 2012 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro Tem Clyde Balvanz presiding and Council Members Doug Berger, Shawn Geer and Kathy Remley present. Mayor Tom Geise and Council Member Kyle Adams were absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: City Clerk Brittney Lentz, Fire Chief Tom Poppe, Librarian Clarence Bergmann and Maintenance Superintendent Andy Luck.

Motion Geer, seconded by Balvanz to approve the agenda. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Remley, seconded by Berger to approve the consent agenda; which included the minutes of September 11, 2012, bills for the month of October 2012 and the Clerk's Reports. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Mayor Pro Tem Balvanz read Ordinance No. 23: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 135.14, BY ADDING AN ADDITIONAL SECTION 135.4(6), AS IT RELATES TO PLACEMENT OF RURAL MAILBOXES NEAR AN INTERSECTION. No comments were received.

Motion Geer, seconded by Berger to approve the third reading of Ordinance No. 23: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 135.14, BY ADDING AN ADDITIONAL SECTION 135.4(6), AS IT RELATES TO PLACEMENT OF RURAL MAILBOXES NEAR AN INTERSECTION. Motion Geer, seconded by Berger to authorize Mayor Pro Tem Balvanz to sign a Pump Service Agreement to continue the City's annual agreement with Electric Pump. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Geer, seconded by Remley to accept the monthly department reports. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Nuisance Abatements were discussed; one letter will be sent out for an abandoned vehicle due to a neighbor complaint.
