September 14, 2010**

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Tim Neil and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Tom Geise.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session September 14, 2010 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tim Neil presiding and council members Shawn Geer, Tom Geise, Larry Poppe and Kathy Remley present. Council member Clyde Balvanz was absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: Bremer County Sheriff Deputy Robert Whitney, City Clerk Brittney Lentz, Librarian Kim Bigelow and Maintenance Supervisor Steve Janssen.

Motion Geise, Remley to approve the agenda. Ayes: Geer, Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Geise, Poppe to approve the consent agenda; which included the minutes of August 10, 2010, bills for the month of September 2010 and the Clerk's Reports. Ayes: Geer, Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Mayor Tim Neil opened the public hearing at 7:05 p.m. concerning Ordinance No.23: Mosquito Spraying. No comments were received.

Motion Poppe, Geise to adopt Ordinance No. 23: An Ordinance establishing a method to control the growth of mosquitoes for the enhancement of the health and safety of the residents of the City and for the billing and collection of fees for mosquito spraying services provided by the City of Plainfield. A Nuisance Abatement was discussed, no action was taken.

Discussion was held with Deputy Whitney on all the break-ins/vandalism in the city. A picnic table was also stolen from Gallagher Park.

The Plainfield Public Library is still looking for a new board member.

Maintenance Supervisor Janssen reported to the Council that the new flow meter at the lagoons has been installed.

David Lehmen was present to discuss extending the storm sewer. No action was taken at this time.

Motion Geise, Geer to adopt Resolution No. 10-05: A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Plainfield, Iowa, approving the Fiscal Year 2010 Street Financial Report. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Geer, Geise, Poppe and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

The Welcome Sign update was tabled.
