

**CITY OF PLAINFIELD
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
September 6, 2011**

Invocation for the Plainfield City Council meeting was given by Pastor Shawn Geer and Pledge of Allegiance was also led by Mayor Geise.

The Plainfield City Council met in regular monthly session September 6, 2011 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tom Geise presiding and council members Clyde Balvanz, Doug Berger, Shawn Geer and Kathy Remley present. Council Member Larry Poppe was absent.

The following department heads were in attendance: City Clerk Brittney Lentz and Maintenance Supervisor Steve Janssen.

Motion Berger, seconded by Remley to approve the agenda. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Balvanz, seconded by Geer to approve the consent agenda; which included the minutes of August 9, 2011, bills for the month of September 2011 and the Clerk's Reports. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

City Clerk Lentz updated the Council on the 403 Center Street property. City Attorney Goeke said they just received the title opinion and closing will be scheduled in the next week or two.

Maintenance Supervisor Janssen updated the Council on the city maintenance shed and property. Steve Bussey has surveyed the property and emailed the plat to City Clerk Lentz. A building sketch will be drawn up soon.

Council Member Geer reported that the First Responders will be doing a Community CPR training yet this Fall. An official date will be set soon.

Maintenance Supervisor Janssen discussed the need to replace the sensophone alarm system at the water tower; since it has not been working properly and parts are no longer available. Motion Geer, seconded by Remley to replace the alarm system with a similar one not to exceed \$1,000. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Geer, seconded by Berger to accept the monthly department reports. Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion Balvanz, seconded by Remley to adopt Resolution No: 11-10: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLAINFIELD, IOWA, APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 STREET FINANCIAL REPORT. Roll call vote- Ayes: Balvanz, Berger, Geer and Remley. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

More Nuisance Abatement letters will be mailed out soon.

Discussion was held on the Welcome Sign. Council Members looked at 3 different designs. Nagle Signs will also be drawing up plans to look at.
