

**CITY OF PLAINFIELD**  
**SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

**January 20, 2014**

The Plainfield City Council met in a special session Monday January 20, 2014 at the Plainfield Public Library at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Tom Geise presiding and Council Members Kyle Adams, Clyde Balvanz, Blake Franzen, Kathy Remley and Joe Schmall present. There were no department heads in attendance or visitors.

Motion Remley, seconded by Adams to approve the agenda with the following amendments. Appointed Balvanz as Clerk Pro-tem, removed item 4 from agenda, added item 4A to discuss Bremer County Foundation Grant opportunity. Ayes: Adams, Balvanz, Franzen, Remley and Schmall. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Discussion was held in regards to the clerk interview process that occurred Saturday January 18<sup>th</sup>. Recommendation from Adams and Balvanz to offer position to Britteny Lentz at a wage of \$18.50 per hour. Motioned by Schmall, seconded by Franzen to extend offer as recommended. Discussion was held in regards to the Bremer County Foundation having funds available through a grant process. These potential funds could be used towards office furniture in the new city building. Applications are available on line. Geise to investigate and advise at February council meeting or if deadline is sooner will assign to a council member to submit a grant form.
